3. CCCS would like to understand if and how the release of the Parties from the Undertaking with respect to both the Singapore-Melbourne (and vice-versa) and Singapore-Brisbane (and vice-versa) routes would affect interested parties in respect of the below:
 - a. How would the release of the Parties from the Undertaking affect ticket prices and seat availability of air passenger travel for **direct flights** between Singapore and Australia, especially for the SIN-MEL vv and SIN-BNE vv routes?
 - b. How would the release of the Parties from the Undertaking affect ticket prices and seat availability of air passenger travel for **flights from Singapore transiting in Melbourne and/or Brisbane** to an Australian or non-Australian city?
 - c. Would the Parties' competitors along the SIN-MEL vv route be able to fulfil any additional demand arising from EK's withdrawal from the SIN-MEL vv route?
 - d. How would the release of the Parties from the capacity commitments with respect to both the SIN-MEL vv and SIN-BNE vv route affect prices and capacity of air freight services between Singapore and Australia?
 - e. Are you aware of whether another airline might consider entering the SIN-MEL vv and/or SIN-BNE vv routes?

- f. Are there any other effects (positive or negative) arising from the release of the Parties from the Undertaking with respect to the SIN-MEL vv and SIN-BNE vv route?
- g. Please share with us any other views or information that you consider would be useful in CCCS's assessment.
